On Sept. 22, 2016, I mailed Ms. Booth a copy of the email (Exhibit 1) I sent the President of Columbia U., with a certificate of mailing (Exhibit 2). On Oct. 11, I called the above number and asked to speak to Ms. Booth. I explained that my call was about my email to President Bollinger.
On Oct. 12, I got a telephone call from Diedre Fuchs, Director of Investigations of the Department of Public Safety, telling me that I was violating her order, given to me in person on Sept. 22, by sending an email (Exhibit 3) to the University Chaplain, Jewelnel Davis. Ms. Fuchs sent me an email (Exhibit 4) and I responded (Exhibit 5).

On Oct. 13, I got a letter from Ms. Booth (Exhibit 6) threatening me with legal action. Following the directive in the letter, I responded with an email (Exhibit 7) to Ms. Fuchs threatening to file a disciplinary complaint against Ms. Booth with the New York Bar Association.

On Sept. 29, I filed a complaint against Columbia U. with the National Association of Scholars for violating the academic freedom of its students and faculty. My correspondence with the NAS is here:
